Abstract: The Ecological Footprint makes sustainability tangible. It is a way to measure what has been immeasurable, contentious, and often misunderstood: ecological limits. This tool simply compares people's demand on resources with nature's ability to renew them. It does this by quantifying land and water area needed to provide resources and absorb the waste of human activities, using prevailing technology. This one-day training provides a unique opportunity to get a hands-on head start into the science and applications of Ecological Footprinting.
