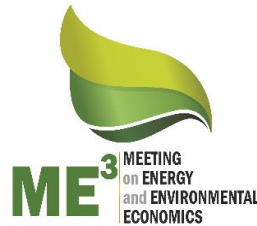


Call for papers



It is a great honour for us to announce the **4th Meeting on Energy and Environmental Economics – ME³** organized by the Portuguese Association of Energy Economics (APEEN) and the Research Centre in Governance, Competitiveness and Public Policy (GOVCOPP) that will be held at DEGEIT at the University of Aveiro, on 21 and 22 September, 2017

Conference details

As it has been in the past two years, the ME³ is an international meeting that aims at sharing experiences and results by the Scientific and Business community whose interests are the Economics of Energy and Environment.

The event will have as usual **scientific sessions** and an afternoon of **presentations/round tables with municipalities**, whose representatives will discuss the theme: "Are energy and environmental efficiency policies making the difference "in greening" or it is still missing something? What has already been done and what could be done additionally."

In addition to the general topics of energy and environmental economics, this year's meeting has a special focus on "green" municipalities or cities, and on the economic and environmental impact, this "greening" can bring. In this sense, we will have two special sessions with representatives of municipalities and regional agencies that will tell us about their experiences and / or expectations about energy, water or waste behaviours at municipal and regional level.

Opportunity MsC and PhD students in the area

Prize for the 3 best videos explaining MsC and PhD ongoing works on the field

There will be a special session in the 4th Meeting of Energy and Environmental Economics where master and doctoral students have a premium opportunity. Students should send 15 minutes videos to be presented at this special session and the three best videos would be announced.

These short videos would be prepared by students in the field of energy economics where in at most 15 minutes they had to talk about their proposals of dissertations, the work they are developing, the difficulties faced, data, methodologies, main conclusions reached thus far, and any other issue they assume to be relevant.

At this session, the young researcher can:

- (i) Meet other young researchers like him
- (ii) Expose his work and practice his oral and written skills of public presentation
- (iii) Receive comments from old researchers and young colleagues in an informal context - Each participant will receive previously the video of another participant to discuss the ideas, methodologies, data and work under development, and should send the constructive comments to be evaluated.

The three best video students selected would have to be present at this special session, preferentially, in order to receive the necessary feedback from old researchers and young colleagues in order to stimulate them.

These students could attend the seminar without any fee and it's possible to have students participating without presenting (for a limited numbers of registrations) as long as they have sent the video.

The premium would be:

- 350€ for the first place;
- 225€ for the second;
- 125€ for the third place

Besides the monetary price we would give to the three best video students one year of APEEN associate membership and no fees to attend the special session organized for them.

Requirement: In order to be able to send the video the student has to register itself in the APEEN website as member. If the student wins, the annual fee payed for the inscription will be sent back. Registrations as APEEN members and videos sent have the same due date as **paper submission: 9th June 2017**.
